### **Goals**

The primary goals of the CSO Breakfast Club are to:

- Establish club chapters in major cities where the need and interest exists.
- Continuously measure the effectiveness of the club at achieving its mission and goals.
- Ensure that members are of relatively equal stature so that issues and discussions are relevant, pertinent and consistent.
- Stay within its annual budget.
- Work with vendors and industry experts to help achieve the club's mission.
- Provide closed-door sessions at events where members can speak freely without concern about disclosure of information discussed in those sessions.

### **Advisory Council**

The CSO Breakfast Club will establish an Advisory Council which will be a voluntary entity with members representing each active chapter that helps the Executive Directors achieve the Club's mission and goals. The Advisory Council members will be invited by the Executive Directors to sit on the Council. Council members serve voluntarily. Council members will serve one year terms. Council members will represent the membership of the club to ensure that the club continually meets the needs of the members.



### **Mutual Non-Disclosure Agreement**

Club members will be asked to sign a mutual non-disclosure agreement (M/NDA) that expresses their commitment to maintaining the privacy and security of information exchanged at Club events. The Club shall require that an active M/NDA be on file for persons who wish to participate in closed-door sessions.
